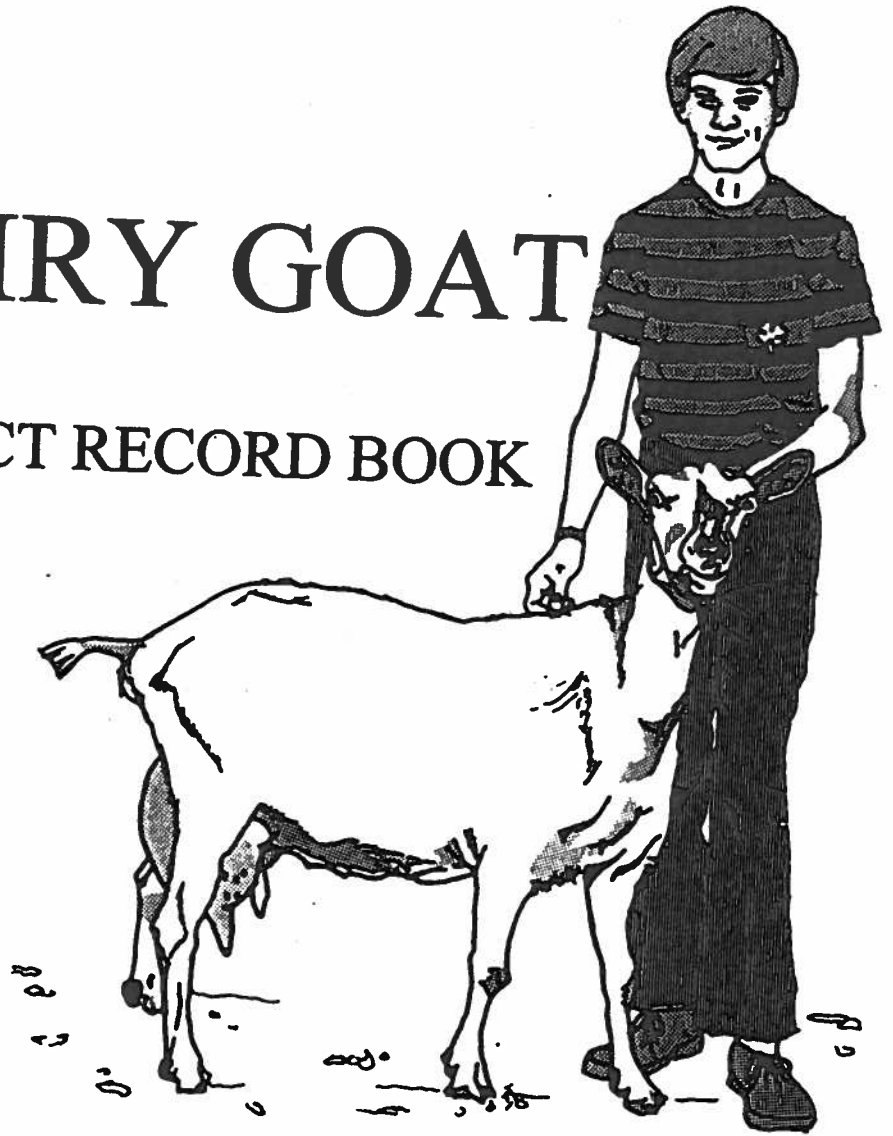

## **4-H PROJECT/PROGRAM PARTICIPATION GUIDELINE**

**A 4-H'er must be eight (8) years of age at the beginning of the current 4-H program year (September 1) to be eligible to enroll in a large animal 4-H project (beef, dairy, emu, goat, horse, llama, ostrich, sheep, swine) and to own a large animal.**

**A 4-H'er who turns eight (8) after the beginning of the current 4-H program year (September 1) may learn about large animals through attendance at meetings or through field trips. They cannot participate, however, in 4-H activities that bring them in contact with large animals.**

**Families (parents or guardians) assume all risk and responsibility of young children if assisting 4-H siblings with large animals.**

Consider depreciation or appreciation of equipment where possible.  
 Example: A halter costs \$10.00 new and lasts for 10 years at which time it is worn out.

$$\text{Depreciation per year} = \frac{\text{original cost}}{\# \text{ OF USEFUL YRS.}} = \frac{10.00}{10} = \$1.00$$

Subtract \$1.00 for each year the halter is used. A halter which is 5 years old is worth \$5.00.
